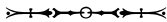

## Emerson Burr Grant

Held Saturday of week 1 at the end of each Pony Division



Any riders who compete in the Children's Pony, Regular Hunter Pony, Green Hunter Pony, USEF Pony Medal, or Pony Jumper sections are eligible to participate in the Emerson Burr Program. Participants are divided into four age groups: 8 and under, 9-11, 12-14, and 15-17. Every participant will take a multiple choice written test on horsemanship. USEF will provide the test which is usually 15 to 20 questions. The top four in each age group who score the highest on the written test will move on to the hands-on horsemanship test. The hands on test requires that the participant demonstrate horsemanship with a pony. They can be required to put on leg wraps, assemble a bridle, etc... After the hands-on test a winner will be chosen from each age group based on his/her horsemanship knowledge. Each winner at the zone level will receive a \$100 grant from the USEF. The grants can be used for educational or equestrian related expenses.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

**Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due

notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. Each horse entered for competition will be assessed a USEF Federation Fee of \$16 (\$8 Drug and Medication/\$8 USEF) and a \$2 USHJA fee.

**While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, the Classic Company, Ltd. and its management assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.**

**Entries:** The closing date for entries of the Atlanta Summer Classic is **Wednesday, May 23, 2012**. After that date stall fees are non-refundable. A **\$25 late fee** for all hunter/jumper classes applies. Entries should be sent to the address shown on the entry blank. Checks should be made payable to Atlanta Classic. Numbers WILL NOT be issued without a SIGNED OPEN CHECK lodged with the Horse Show Secretary. The entry form for each show must include the following:

- Horse name and complete description;
- All classes or divisions entered;
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting;
- Organization membership numbers;
- Social Security or Federal ID number of owner.

**Stalls:** Stalls with doors are \$225 per week. If paid in full by closing date, the stall fee is \$200. In order to receive the pre-paid rate of \$200 per week, for horse or tack stalls, each

weeks entry blanks must be completed in full and payment received with a filled out check or credit card with the amount clearly noted as to where the amount is to be applied, prior to the closing date. If the credit card number is on the entry blank and is received prior to closing date, the credit card will be charged the pre-paid rate. **The closing date of Wednesday, May 23, 2012 will be strictly enforced for this discount.** In order to insure on time delivery we encourage the use of an overnight carrier to the following address: Classic Company, 3598 Wild Plum Road, Johns Island, SC 29455. Trainers please include a note indicating the TOTAL number of stalls required, horse and tack, and a good contact number.

**Stabling:** Stalls will be 12'x12' permanent with doors and ceiling fans or 10'x10' portable stalls under tents. Initial bedding will not be provided. Stalls, whether occupied by horse, feed, or tack will be starting before Monday, June 11, 2012.

**Early Arrival:** Early arrival is any stall used for horses or tack starting before Monday, June 11th. The fee for early arrival is \$20 per stall per night and \$30 per RV site (hooked or unhooked). RV's may be parked early in the Trailer lot at no fee. For early arrival information please call 843-768-5503.

**Motor Homes:** At the Atlanta Summer Classics motor homes and camper sites are available but limited this year. **To ensure a camper space please complete the camper reservation form and return with payment (check or credit card) before arrival. \$225 weekly.** (Includes septic or one pump out per week.) A \$50 fee will be added if not received by closing date.

## Competition Office Hours

**Competition Days:** Office opens one hour before the start of the first class and closes 30 minutes following the last class.

## Non-Competition Days:

Mondays: 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon,  
Tuesdays: 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

**Refunds:** Full refunds will be given before the closing date. After the closing date, entry fees will be refunded; however, stall

fees are non-refundable. Scratch fees have been eliminated.

**Check Out:** Any horse show bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show will be assessed a \$50 fee for check out. Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. Please review your bills carefully.

**Day Exhibitors:** Horses entered but not stabled at the horse show must use the designated area for day exhibitors. \$40 grounds fee will be assessed; however, breeding horses will be charged \$20.

## Opportunity Classes: Hunter/Jumper/Equitation Divisions

1. Opportunity Classes are for entry level riders.
2. May be held at USEF regular or local rated competitions.
3. All Opportunity classes and divisions must have fences 2'6" or below.
4. Any rider that has shown in a regular division (such as regular ponies) is not eligible.
5. All rules and regulations in section GR821 should be followed, except GR821.7 (no crossing over into rated divisions).

**Service Fee:** All horses, showing or non-showing, will be charged a \$35 fee. This fee allows the horse UNLIMITED add/scratches from classes, access to schooling areas and rings at designated times and defers all charges for parking passes; however, classes not scratched in the Horse Show Office will be billed.

**Splitting of Tack Stalls:** The Horse Show Office will be happy to split the tack stalls per the Trainers instructions among his/her customers up to each Friday at 11:00 am. At that point, the total amount will be billed to the trainer's barn account.

**Schooling:** Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. This includes riding, exercising and lunging. A \$100 fine will be assessed for anyone caught in the rings before or after the show without permission and will be eliminated from the competition.

**Lunging:** All lunging will be restricted to designated areas. Lunging will not be permitted in ANY ring areas at any time.

**Feed & Bedding:** Hay, grain, and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For same day delivery, feed orders must be received prior to 12:00 noon. For feed and bedding reservations prior to arrival, please call Queen Enterprises at 770-860-9111. If there is any question, USEF rule 1219.7 any barn may bring their own feed and bedding to the show grounds for their own use.

**Farrier:** No farrier other than the official competition farrier will be permitted to shoe on the grounds without express permission of the management. Exhibitors wishing to use another farrier must request a permit for that farrier at the Horse Show Office.

**Non-Negotiable Checks:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 15% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

**Poling and Offsets:** Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited for all horses competing in the Atlanta Spring Classics. Any rider, trainer, groom, or any other person who is in violation of the rules set forth above will be fined \$500 for each incident and may be suspended from further competition for the duration of the scheduled competition starting from the time of the incident. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offsets rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for the duration of the scheduled competition. All entry fees for the classes entered during the suspended period of the horse in question will be forfeited.

**Canadian Exhibitors:** The legend "U.S. Fund" must be pre-printed on the face of all Canadian checks drawn on Canadian banks used to pay entry fees. Canadians must also have a U.S. Social Security number or a TIN number.

## Formal Attire

**Hunters:** Scarlet, black or dark blue coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, buff, or canary breeches; hunt cap, derby or hunting silk hat. Juniors must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF rules. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Equitation:** Black, dark blue, dark green, or dark gray coat; white shirt with white stock, tie or choker, white, beige or canary breeches. Juniors must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF rules. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts:** Under new Georgia State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles — ATVs, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 301.

**Parking:** Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

**Protective Headgear:** All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting protective headgear when mounted on the show grounds. For further information, please reference USEF GR 318.

**Minor Exhibitors:** Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate

the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Caveat:** Due to uncertainty:

- all Hunter Classics with prize money require 6 entries or the classes may be combined or cancelled;
- all Jumper Classes with prize money require 5 entries or the class may be cancelled.
- Junior/AO Jumper Classes and Classics require 8 entries in each section. If there are not eight it will be combined. High will pay high entry fee and receive high prize money and low will pay low entry fee and receive low prize money.

**Dogs:** All dogs must be restrained at all times while on the show grounds. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Keep dogs on a leash for their protection and to abide by the rules of the Georgia International Horse Park. Loose dogs will not be tolerated in the show ring area. The dogs will be impounded and the owner charged \$100 that will be donated to the Humane Society.

**Prize Money:** Prize money will only be awarded to the recipient of record on the entry blank provided there is valid Social Security number or Federal ID number and corresponding name and address. Prize money will be printed at the conclusion of the event. During multiple week events, prize money checks can be picked up in the Horse Show Office on Thursday. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days of the conclusion of the event. Please confirm information on entry form is correct to insure prompt and accurate delivery of prize money.

**Prize Money to Foreign Exhibitors:** Foreign exhibitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of the prize money won in the United States. Foreign exhibitors must have a U.S. Social Security number or TIN number prior to prize money being issued.

**Electrical/Fire Regulations:** All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

**Non-Showing Horses:** All non-showing horses must complete an entry blank and be assigned a back number. All Non-showing horses will pay \$50 per week plus a service fee of \$35.

**Ticketed Warm-Up:** Tickets may be purchased in the Horse Show Office.

## ADDITIONAL TERMS AND DEFINITIONS OF THE RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION

In consideration for entry upon the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES of the COMPETITION, the undersigned on behalf of myself, my trainers, instructors, coaches, clients, agents, employees, grooms, invitees, representatives, assigns, executors, heirs, independent contractors (including but not limited to veterinarians, farriers, masseuse, chiropractor, therapists, braiders, shippers), and, if applicable, on behalf of my minor child or children (hereinafter collectively referred to as "I") agrees:

I agree that COMPETITION as used in this entry blank, in the prize list and in the USEF rules means Atlanta Summer Classic Horse Show, each and every class and/or event conducted and ALL ACTIVITIES that I undertake AT ANY TIME and for any purpose upon entry of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES including any horse which is on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for my use, in my control or at my request. I further agree

that COMPETITION includes the entire week of the horse show including the time horses and/or people are allowed to enter to set up, stable and/or conduct business whether its expressly and/or specifically related to the horse show and classes being conducted/held that week through and including the time all horses and/or people vacate the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES.

I agree that this Release of Liability includes any horse that I have asked to come onto the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES for any purpose, and/or is in my control and/or custody and regardless whether the horse is being stabled at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or competing in the COMPETITION.

I agree that "RELEASED PARTIES" means the "Competition" known as Atlanta Summer Classic Horse Show, the "Horse Show Management" and/or "Competition Management" as referenced in the prize list, the Federation Licensee, Classic Company and Georgia International Horse Park and each of their officers, directors, managers, members, owners, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, subsidiaries, volunteers, officials, affiliated and associated persons, companies and organizations, assigns and entities or organizations as may now or hereafter be constituted, that own, are related to or manage the property owned by such entities.

I agree that SHOW GROUND FACILITIES means the Georgia International Horse Park including but not limited to all improvements, structures (permanent or temporary), buildings, tents, stalls, fixtures (including but not limited to all jumps and related equipment), arenas (and the footing therein) located on the premises and/or provided by RELEASED PARTIES during the COMPETITION.

I agree that if I am not a member of the Federation that I will abide by all rules and regulations of the Federation. I agree that the Rules of the Prize List are incorporated as if set forth herein.

**Release and Waiver of Claims:** I hereby fully and forever release, waive and discharge the RELEASED PARTIES and each of them who are or might be liable in any way from any

and all claims, demands, actions, causes of actions, liabilities of any kind which I may or might have against RELEASED PARTIES or any of them, arising from or by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, injury to horse and any consequences thereof, which I may sustain due to the ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES; I further agree that except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the RELEASED PARTIES, I SHALL NOT SUE or bring any legal action, claim, and/or demand against for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage and/or injury to any horse in relation to the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or the operation and conduct of the COMPETITION. I agree this RELEASE INCLUDES ALL ACTIVITIES I PARTICIPATE IN AND ALL AREAS OF THE SHOW GROUND FACILITIES as defined above. This release also includes all activities I conduct at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and includes all times that I am at the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES no matter what the purpose and/or activity being undertaken.

**Hold Harmless:** I hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES from and against any and all claims, liabilities, loss, damages, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys' fees, cost and expenses of any kind, which may be made against them, or any of them, which arise out of the active or passive negligence of RELEASED PARTIES while either I or any horse at my request or in my control is/was on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or participating in the COMPETITION. **Assumption of Risk:** I hereby acknowledge and assume the risk that equestrian activity, including jumping, is very dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I expressly acknowledge that injuries may be compounded or increased by negligent maintenance of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES, faulty or improperly secured equipment, improper supervision or compliance with Federation rules and regulations. Acts of God and negligent rescue operations or procedures of RELEASED PARTIES and negligent handling of horses and independent operations by trainers, riders and/or boarders who use the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES or others who are not affiliated with RELEASED PARTIES. I acknowledge that horses can be injured while being ridden, groomed, stabled, walked and/or exercised and I expressly assume the risk of injury to any horse under my control and/or custody or on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES at my request.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia with respect to all RELEASED PARTIES, except for the Federation as set forth on page one. I agree this Release extends to all acts of ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law. ## 2012 Zone 4 Specifications (AL, FL, GA, MS, SC, TN)

In accordance with GR 1111.4: **Contiguous states are: AR, KY, LA, MO, NC, VA.**

**Adult Amateur Hunter:** Adult Amateur Hunter classes are for amateurs 18 years of age or older showing horses and/or ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. Adult Amateur Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

**Children's Hunter:** Children's Hunter classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing horses. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Children's Hunters section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section. Children's Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class, but may not cross-enter into any Junior Hunter or Junior Jumper class at the same show. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible.

**Children's Hunter Pony:** Children's Hunter Pony classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. Suitability (size) of pony to rider is of particular importance. The Small/Medium Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2' and Large

Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2'6". The section may be divided at managements' discretion. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section. Rider age restrictions as found in "Regular Pony" sections do not apply. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the "Regular" Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3". Exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers. Ponies exhibiting in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible **but the rider may not show the same pony in the regular pony section.**

**Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. The rider is not eligible to compete in any jumper class above 1.15m (3'9") that offer prize money at the same show. Once a rider has competed in jumper classes over 1.15m (3'9") that offers prize money, the same rider cannot show in a Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper class or classic offering \$500 or more for 30 days. Fences at 1.10m or 3'6" to 1.15m (3'9").

**Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. Riders in Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m (3'9") at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show, but not on the same day as showing in the Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence height 1.00m (3'3").
